Introduction

Asia is unique in its rich and diverse cultures, religions, natural and human resources. Unfortunately, the vast majority of people still live below the poverty line. Asia is connected to the greater world. This world is witnessing different forms of conflict and violence. Sectarian and communal violence, suppression and deprivation of ethnic and religious minorities, invasion, occupation, war, and the nuclear arms race have dashed not only the hopes and aspirations for a peaceful, harmonious and prosperous global community but have also produced extremism . Part of it, is due to colonial legacies, dictatorial incompetence and corrupt governance.

At the macro level it is the polarization around ideology and control of natural resources, economic globalization and competition between power blocks to exert arrogance and influence on rest of the world. It started after the Soviet Union sent soldiers to Afghanistan to support, the-then pro-Soviet government. That is the time the Western world and Muslim world came together and lent support to the Taliban to oust the Soviet Union from Afghanistan. Finally, the Soviet Union had to withdraw. That paved the way for the emergence of new forces namely Taliban and later on ISI, after the American-led coalition invaded Iraq.

After Iraq, the wave Arab Spring spread. So was the speed of regime change, Libya was the next victim of Western invasion. Change in Tunisia and Egypt took place without foreign invasion. It started in Syria, this time Iran and Russia extended support to Hafez al- Assad. ISIS declared Caliphate in Iraq and Syria. The new trend of resistance and extreme form of movement has engulfed many countries. Hundreds of thousands of people died and millions became refugees. More and more young, educated persons and professionals are also joining the movements to regain their version of Islamic supremacy. Terrorist attacks are also taking place in all continents.

It is against this backdrop that the youth for peace course is designed to empower young people with knowledge, analytical skills and right-motivation to engage in peace and development activities. It aims to foster leadership, networking trans - border solidarity to promote collective human dignity, welfare and peace.

Young leaders, scholars, teachers, post graduate students, NGO and social workers, and anyone else with a keen interest in approaching peacebuilding creatively

Partcipants will get an understanding and dimension of peace and conflict. As a student/professional you will gain and build up knowledge and skills in promoting peace.
